SAT Seminar

- Each seminar includes four separate sessions.
- Each seminar will include effective strategies for the three main sections of the new SAT: Critical Reading, Math, and Writing.
- An SAT Prep book will be provided with full-length practice tests and additional strategies and practice problems.
- A study guide will be given to you to plan your study time during the four week period of the seminar.
- Specific homework assignments, designed to reinforce and practice key strategies, will also be given.
- Optional tutoring will be available to address individual needs. You may sign up for 10 hours of tutoring at a savings of \$5 per hour, or you may choose your own number of tutoring hours at \$30 per hour (billed separately).

Questions & Answers

• **What if my schedule conflicts with the seminar dates and times?**

If possible, we would be glad to make arrangements with you individually to set up tutoring or another time to take the seminar.

• **Why is going to each of the 4 sessions important?**

You will receive important strategies and hints at each session that are not included in your book. Different material will be covered in each session.

• **What will I get out of the SAT Seminar?**

You will get out of the seminar what you put in. In other words, if you are diligent about practicing the strategies throughout the seminar, you will benefit more than if you wait until the last minute to study.

• **What happens if I miss one of the sessions?**

You will have a chance to make up the session you missed during one of the other seminars if it is before your test date. Otherwise, you may want to contact your instructor to get any missed information.

• **Is completing the assigned homework important every session?**

The homework assignments have been designed to coordinate with the material taught in each session. It is extremely important to practice these strategies before you take the SAT. The more practice you do, the better your scores will be.

• **What is expected for each session?**

The instructor will expect you to arrive on time, stay for the entire session, and come prepared. You will get more out of the seminar if you are diligent in studying and doing your homework. Remember, more options in college will be available to you if you have higher scores on the SAT.

• **What if I need extra help in one or more areas?**

In order to address your specific needs, we can work on areas of concern during separate tutoring sessions. This will give you reinforcement in the more challenging areas for you.
